



Waste Container Guidelines

Loading Container – To comply with the laws and regulations of the State of GA, the customer must load the container properly in order to be transported to the dump, and must not overload the container with excessive weight. In keeping with the State of GA mandated coverage regulations, the containers must be loaded level, even with the sides, with no material above the sides. This will allow a tarp to be appropriately placed over the waste for transportation. The customer will be responsible for any fines incurred as a result of improper loading. As mandated by the State of GA weight restrictions, we can't except any containers loaded heavier than these weights listed:

Container Size	Max Weight
10 Yd	5 Tons
20 Yd.	10 Tons
30 Yd.	10 Tons
40 Yd.	10 Tons

Rental Fees - Pricing includes 14 days of use. No additional fees will be charged if the container is requested to be picked up on the 14th day, with day one counted as the day of delivery. The dumpster will not be picked up automatically at end of the 14 day rental period, the request must be called in to the office. If dumpster stay exceeds the 14 day period without being dumped there will be a \$5.00 per day fee charged to the account until requested to be picked up. If the dumpster is picked up and dumped, the 14 day free period begins again after the dump.

Dump Fees - Containers will be weighed after leaving the job site and before it is dumped. Any additional charges due to excess tonnage in the container will be automatically charged to the account. Unless otherwise specified in the signed Rental Agreement, excess tonnage will be charged at the rate of \$35.00 per ton in accordance with the following schedule:

Acceptable Waste - The waste material to be collected and disposed of by ASAP Glenn Company, Inc. pursuant to the signed agreement must be solid waste generated by the customer excluding radioactive, volatile, highly flammable, explosive, biomedical, infectious, toxic, used oil, oil filters, batteries, tires, or hazardous material. The term "hazardous material" shall include, but not be limited any amount of waste listed or characterized as hazardous by the United States Environmental Protection Agency or any state agency pursuant to the Regressor Conservation and Recovery Act of 1978, as attended, or applicable state law. ASAP Glenn Company will acquire waste material when loaded into trucks. Title to and liability for any waste excluded above shall reside with the customer and the customer expressly agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless ASAP Glenn Company, Inc. from and against any and all damages, penalties, fines, and legalities resulting from and arising out of such waste excluded above. Unacceptable items include but are not limited to the following: diesel fuel, gasoline, oil, transmission fluid, brake and steering fluid. Other items such as mattresses, asbestos, household garbage, etc. will be accepted, but will incur an additional charge. If there is a question concerning unacceptable waste, please call the office at 706-549-ASAP (2727). Railroad ties are acceptable but must be cut into 4 feet lengths.
